Stop the Spread – Remain Fully Mission Capable

What: Mandatory procedures for individuals identified as a close contact or after known exposure

Who: Any person who is identified as a close contact to an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19, or has a known exposure to a COVID positive case

When: Immediately after exposure or being notified as a close contact

MEDICAL CLOSE CONTACT PROCEDURES (REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS):

- This applies to anyone named as a close contact regardless of vaccination status:
 - o NO quarantine is required
 - Observe for symptoms (fever, cough, muscle aches, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, etc.)
 - Wear a fitted mask for 10 days (day 0 is the day last exposed to a. individual who has tested positive for COVID-19)
 - o Service members in the workplace must test at least once after 5 full days following exposure
 - o If symptoms arise, you must test and isolate yourself until results are verified by a healthcare provider
 - o Provide your test results (positive or negative) to the 354 MDG (call 907-377-1847) to receive further guidance.
 - If you are experiencing chest pains or have difficulty breathing, please seek emergency care or call 911.

Personnel, without symptoms, may stop by the 354 MDG Family Health Front Desk to obtain FREE COVID-19 test kits.

DO NOT GO TO WORK if you develop any COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, or other flu-like symptoms)

Isolate yourself from others, inform your chain of command, and contact the 354 MDG AT 907-377-1847.
