Stop the Spread – Remain Fully Mission Capable

What: COVID-19 Drive-up Testing procedures at the 354th MDG

Who: Any person with symptoms consistent or concerning for COVID-19

Any person directed to be tested by 354 FW Public Health for known exposure to COVID-19 after contact tracing

When: 0730-1200 Mon-Fri (closed on 354 FW down days & Federal Holidays)

INSTRUCTIONS

- Proceed to the designated testing location by route on the below map.
 - In front of your parking spot, there will be a sign with a number to call from your cell phone.
 - If you do not have a phone, the technician will approach your vehicle after waiting roughly 3-5 min.
 - The technician will ask <u>if you have symptoms</u> or if you are a <u>contact trace without symptoms</u>.
 - Patients with symptoms will have ID confirmed, asked to fill out an information sheet, and have vitals taken.
 - Patients without symptoms will be tested after ID is confirmed and reconciled with Public Health.
- Testing will be self-collected with instructions from the medical technician.
- If you are symptomatic, the following criteria will require clinical evaluation prior to testing:
 - Previously tested during this illness
 - o Abnormal vital signs
 - \circ Age < 5 years old
 - Severe symptoms
 - Patient request
- Test follow up all patients will be called with their results within 1 duty day.
- All Patients are given a handout explaining isolation/quarantine procedures.



If you develop any COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, or other flu-like symptoms), **DO NOT GO TO WORK**. Isolate yourself from others, inform your chain of command, and contact the 354 MDG at (907) 377-1847.
