Eielson Air Force Base (AFB) is currently assessing whether there is enough community interest to reestablish a Restoration Advisory Board (RAB). A RAB is a community group which meets to discuss and receive information on environmental restoration (cleanup) projects at Eielson AFB.

A RAB improves communication, outreach, and transparency between the military base, regulators, local governments, interest groups, and the community by providing a structured forum for sharing information and discussing environmental cleanup activities at Eielson AFB. While RABs are not decision-making bodies, they give community members a meaningful opportunity to review cleanup efforts, ask questions, share feedback, and ensure local perspectives are considered throughout the cleanup process.
