Stop the Spread – Remain Fully Mission Capable

What: Guidance for Friends and Family Visiting Eielson AFB

Who: Friends and Family traveling from locations outside of Alaska

GENERAL GUIDANCE:

- We must remain connected with friends and family during this difficult time. The following are reminders to facilitate friends and family visiting Eielson AFB.
- State restrictions are subject to change! Friends and family traveling from locations outside of Alaska must follow Alaska state travel restrictions. For example, travelers from outside of Alaska must currently arrive with proof of a qualifying negative COVID-19 test or receive a COVID-19 test upon arrival in Alaska and follow strict social distancing until results arrive. For the latest restrictions, visit <https://covid19.alaska.gov>. Personnel must review current Alaska restrictions before permitting visitors to enter Eielson AFB.
- All visitors must comply with Eielson AFB's COVID-19 mitigation measures and Alaska state restrictions.
- Members should wear masks and practice social distancing in their residence until visitors have completed ROM under current Alaska travel mandates.
- Visitor passes require unit commander approval.
- Visitor passes can be obtained at the Eielson Visitor Center. Visitors may contact the Eielson Visitor Center at (907) 377-3807.
- Visitors who are not "fully immunized" (2 weeks after the second dose of a two-shot series or 2 weeks after one dose in a single-shot series) may complete travel restriction of movement (ROM) in on-base residences. However, compliance with current COVID-19 mitigation measures is critical to successfully preventing the spread of COVID-19.
- Visitors should consider the following when deciding whether to ROM in on-base residences:
 - Number of visitors
 - Plan for maintaining social distancing during ROM upon arrival
 - Exposure risk
 - Ability to maintain social distancing in work areas during visitor's ROM
 - COVID-19 situation at local and visitor's location

If visitors experience any COVID-19 symptoms, household members must immediately take precautionary measures and notify 354 MDG and their chain of command.

If you develop any COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, loss of taste or smell, or other flu-like symptoms), DO NOT GO TO WORK. Isolate yourself from others, inform your chain of command, and contact the 354 MDG at (907) 377-1847.
