MEDICAL ISOLATION/QUARANTINE vs NON-MEDICAL ROM 26 Mar 21

Stop the Spread – Remain Fully Mission Capable

What: Explanation of Terms – <u>Medical Isolation</u>, <u>Medical Quarantine</u> and <u>Non-Medical Restriction of</u>

Movement (ROM)

Who: All personnel

- MEDICAL ISOLATION Any person DIAGNOSED with COVID-19
 - o Ordered by 354 FW/CC implemented by 354 MDG
 - o NO modifications to guidance given by Public Health
 - o Must remain physically isolated until released by Public Health
 - o Cannot "test-out" of Medical Isolation
 - o For further details, see Handout: Eielson AFB Medical Isolation Guidance
- <u>MEDICAL QUARANTINE</u> Any person identified by 354 MDG as having <u>CONTACT</u> with a diagnosed COVID-19 person
 - o Ordered by 354 FW/CC implemented by 354 MDG through contact tracing
 - o NO modifications to guidance given by Public Health unless authorized by 354 MDG
 - Must remain in quarters for 10 days starts from last date of exposure as determined by Public Health
 - o This is your alternate duty location. You are not on leave.
 - o For further details, see Handout: Eielson AFB Medical Quarantine Guidance
- <u>NON-MEDICAL ROM</u> All personnel <u>TRAVELLING</u> from locations outside of Alaska (including returning Eielson personnel, TDY personnel, transient aircrew, new inbounds, civilians, visitors, family members, etc.)
 - o Installation Policy implemented by commanders, first sergeants, supervisors and YOU
 - o Applies to personnel living on or off base
 - This is your alternate duty location. You are not on leave.
 - Unit Commanders may grant modifications based upon mission needs
 - Only applies to NON-MEDICAL ROMs
 - Commanders <u>cannot</u> modify Medical Isolation or Medical Quarantine procedures
 - Additional restrictions/modifications may apply to Red Flag participants and other TDY personnel
 - o NOTE: Personnel who are "fully immunized" are exempt from the 10-day ROM requirement. For further details, see Handout: *Eielson AFB Restriction of Movement Guidance*.

Personnel who get <u>tested</u> at the 354 MDG COVID Clinic OR personnel who are <u>sick</u> may be directed to immediately <u>go home</u> and follow medical quarantine procedures to await test results or receive further instructions from Public Health.

If you develop any COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, or other flu-like symptoms), **DO NOT GO TO WORK**. Isolate yourself from others, inform your chain of command, and contact the 354 MDG at (907) 377-1847.
