



EIELSON AFB RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT (ROM) GUIDANCE (NON-MEDICAL*)

6 Oct 20

Stop the Spread – Remain Fully Mission Capable

What: Mandatory Restriction of Movement (ROM) Procedures

Who: All personnel traveling from locations outside of Alaska (including returning Eielson personnel, TDY personnel, transient aircrew, new inbounds, civilians, visitors, family members, etc)

When: For a period of 14 days (unless granted a ROM modification as outlined below)

*This guidance does not cover medical isolation and quarantine, defined as follows:

Medical Isolation – person tested positive for COVID-19

Medical Quarantine – person having close contact with someone testing positive for COVID-19

NON-MEDICAL ROM PROCEDURES:

- For a period of 14 days, all inbound and TDY personnel **waiting for a COVID-19 test result OR did not test** upon entering Alaska must follow this guidance:
 - Wear a mask and maintain 6 feet of physical distance from anybody outside of your household.
 - **Do not enter any public facilities on Eielson** (i.e., Baker Field House, AAFES, the Commissary, etc).
 - Any delivery, curbside, or drive-thru contactless service is permitted (mask wear required).
 - Do not enter any restaurants, gyms, community centers, schools, office buildings, or daycare facilities.
 - Outdoor activity is permitted (alone or with family), but avoid high traffic areas and maintain 6 feet distance.
 - **Do not participate in group activities or events.**
 - Unless otherwise directed, personnel are not restricted to base (must follow Alaska guidelines while off base).
 - These guidelines apply to personnel residing off-base.
 - Practice enhanced hand hygiene and home sanitation practices.
 - ***This is your alternate duty location. You are not on leave.***
- The 14 day window can be shortened after receiving a **second negative COVID-19 test** result taken after arrival in to Alaska. Consult your chain of command for further guidance.

NOTE: Travel-related testing is not provided by military treatment facilities.

NON-MEDICAL ROM MODIFICATIONS:

- Unit Commanders may grant ROM modifications for mission needs:
 - A tailored ROM permits accomplishing the mission while taking risk-based precautions.
 - Does not permit entering public spaces or participating in unofficial group activities.
 - **This exception does not apply to medical isolation and quarantine requirements.**
- NOTE: Additional guidance and/or restrictions apply to Red Flag participants, Artic Survival School, transient aircrew and associated personnel, and other specified TDY personnel. Consult your chain of command for further instructions.

*If you develop any COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, or other flu-like symptoms), **DO NOT GO TO WORK.** Isolate yourself from others, inform your chain of command, and contact the 354 MDG at (907) 377-1847.*
