MEMORANDUM FOR ALL TRANSIENT & EXERCISE PERSONNEL

SUBJECT: HPCON Procedures for Transient & Exercise Personnel, Version 8

1. **For the duration of your stay**, personnel will follow any applicable state travel mandates and Eielson AFB COVID-19 guidance. Personnel will also wear masks in the company of others and maintain at least six feet of distancing to the maximum extent practicable. If directed into **Medical Isolation or Medical Quarantine** by the 354 MDG, remain in your lodging/dormroom at all times. You may only exit your lodging/dorm room to receive necessary medical care. **In addition**, transient personnel and aircrew are subject to the following ROM procedures:

### Fully Immunized Personnel

- Personnel **who are fully immunized** (2 weeks after the second dose of a two-shot series or 2 weeks after one dose in a single-shot series) should take a COVID-19 test upon arrival in Alaska or no earlier than 72 hours before departing for Alaska. Fully immunized personnel who comply with this requirement after domestic travel and possess proof of immunization are not required to ROM upon arrival in Alaska.
- A 10-day ROM is required after international travel. Per *DoD Force Health Protection Guidance Supplements 18 (dated 17 Mar 21) and 20 (dated 12 Apr 21)*, commanders will consider exposure risk and mission requirements if allowing personnel to return to work during the ROM period.
- Fully immunized personnel must follow state travel mandates and Eielson AFB COVID-19 guidance (available at: <https://www.eielson.af.mil/coronavirus/>) including mask wear and six feet of distancing to the maximum extent practicable.

### Non-Fully Immunized Personnel

- Personnel **who are not fully immunized** and have returned from out-of-state domestic or international travel will enter a 10-day ROM.
- Personnel may enter on-base public facilities (e.g., BX, Food Court, Gym, etc.) if wearing a mask and maintaining six feet of physical distancing.
- Personnel may use on-base delivery, drive-through, and curbside pickup services.
- Personnel are prohibited from dining-in at restaurants (on or off base).
- Personnel traveling off the installation will comply with Alaska State health mandates.
- Personnel may engage in on or off-base outdoor activities.
- Commanders may adjust ROM procedures based on mission requirements, test results, exposure risk during travel, and ability to maintain social distancing.

2. **After completing a 10-day ROM**, non-fully immunized personnel who have not developed any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 are authorized to operate under current Eielson AFB COVID-19 guidance. Personnel will follow any applicable guidance issued by the State of Alaska for non-residents.

3. Military personnel may face disciplinary action for failure to comply with these instructions.
