Information Repositories for Perflourinated Compounds in Moose Creek Private Wells

Eielson Air Force Base (AFB) is conducting environmental activities in Moose Creek related to perflourinated compounds (PFCs) contamination discovered in private drinking wells. To help keep the residents informed of the process, information concerning PFCs in drinking water is available in two Information Repositories.



What is an Information Repository?
